

RESOLUTION NO. 2935

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR OREGON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, a portion of the North Albany Area has been identified by the Department of Environmental Quality as having one of the most severe health hazards in the state due to inadequate sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has the opportunity to apply for an Oregon Community Development Block Grant (OCDBG) to provide partial funding for sewer system improvements in the North Albany Health Hazard Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that an application for \$500,000 be submitted to the Oregon Economic Development Department and that the Mayor be authorized to sign the application on behalf of the City of Albany.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the first priority for the use of these grant funds be to assist low- and moderate-income households in the area with the cost of sewer assessments and connection fees.
