

RESOLUTION NO. 3329

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the 1993 Legislature approved the funding of the joint Oregon Department of Transportation/Department of Land Conservation and Development Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) program; and

WHEREAS, the program includes approximately \$4.8 million for work by local governments to better integrate transportation and land-use planning and develop new ways to manage growth to achieve compact pedestrian, bicycle, and transit-friendly urban development; and


WHEREAS, a local match of at least 15 percent of the total cost of the project is required; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has identified a priority need to develop a street, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian plan to guide development in the recently annexed North Albany area as a project that meets the grant criteria; and

WHEREAS, this TGM grant application will request a \$50,000 grant and the City of Albany's local match will be \$7,500 in funds or in eligible in-kind services.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY STATE that development of this plan is a priority project and directs staff to prepare and submit an application to the Transportation and Growth Management Program.
