

RESOLUTION NO. 3342

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A MATCHING GRANT APPLICATION TO THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (SBA).

WHEREAS, the Small Business Administration has grants available for the purpose of planting new trees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has removed diseased, damaged, or dead trees from the City right-of-way with no financial means to replace them; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide the financial resources to begin planting trees on newly overlaid streets to enhance and beautify the neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, conditions of obtaining this grant include a three-year maintenance program of in-kind services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes staff to apply for a SBA tree grant in the amount of \$10,500 for the purpose of planting new curb-side trees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, authorizes the City Forester to sign the grant application on behalf of the City.
