

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FOR THE ALBANY ARTS COMMISSION FROM MEYER MEMORIAL TRUST.

WHEREAS, in January 1997, the City Council created the Albany Arts Commission to complete the City Hall Arts Master Plan and promote public visual arts throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Arts Commission plans a public outreach campaign and a series of rotating and traveling art exhibits to highlight the diversity and quality of art in Albany and to provide access to the arts for Albany citizens; and

WHEREAS, the temporary art exhibits will showcase local talent, increase community awareness, and provide access for arts education programs in the community; and



WHEREAS, public art beautifies our public spaces, increases community pride, and enhances Albany's image.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that it authorizes the Albany Arts Commission to apply for a grant for \$3,500 from the Meyer Memorial Trust to be used for the purchase of display equipment for temporary and rotating art displays.
