

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REMOVAL OF PARKING ON WASHINGTON FROM 1ST AVENUE TO 7TH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has recommended the removal of one on-street parking space at the northwest and southeast corners of each public street intersection of Washington Street from 1st Avenue to 7th Avenue, where parking is currently allowed; and


WHEREAS, the parking removal will improve sight distance and visibility at these intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has recognized the competing interests between the need to maintain on-street parking versus the need to conform with nationally accepted minimum standards for stopping sight distance; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has balanced the need for on-street parking against the nationally accepted minimum standards for stopping sight distance.


