

RESOLUTION NO. 3990

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BIKEWAY AND WALKWAY GRANT FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Bicycle and Pedestrian Program distributes competitive grants for construction projects on local streets; and

WHEREAS, a local match of 20 percent is required; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to construct sidewalks, pedestrian crossings, and wheelchair ramps in the vicinities of Albany Public Schools and Albany General Hospital; and

WHEREAS, this ODOT grant application will request \$100,000 for construction of pedestrian and bicycle transportation improvements, and the City of Albany's local match will be approximately \$25,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for the purpose of constructing pedestrian and bicycle transportation improvements in the vicinities of Albany Public Schools and Albany General Hospital.

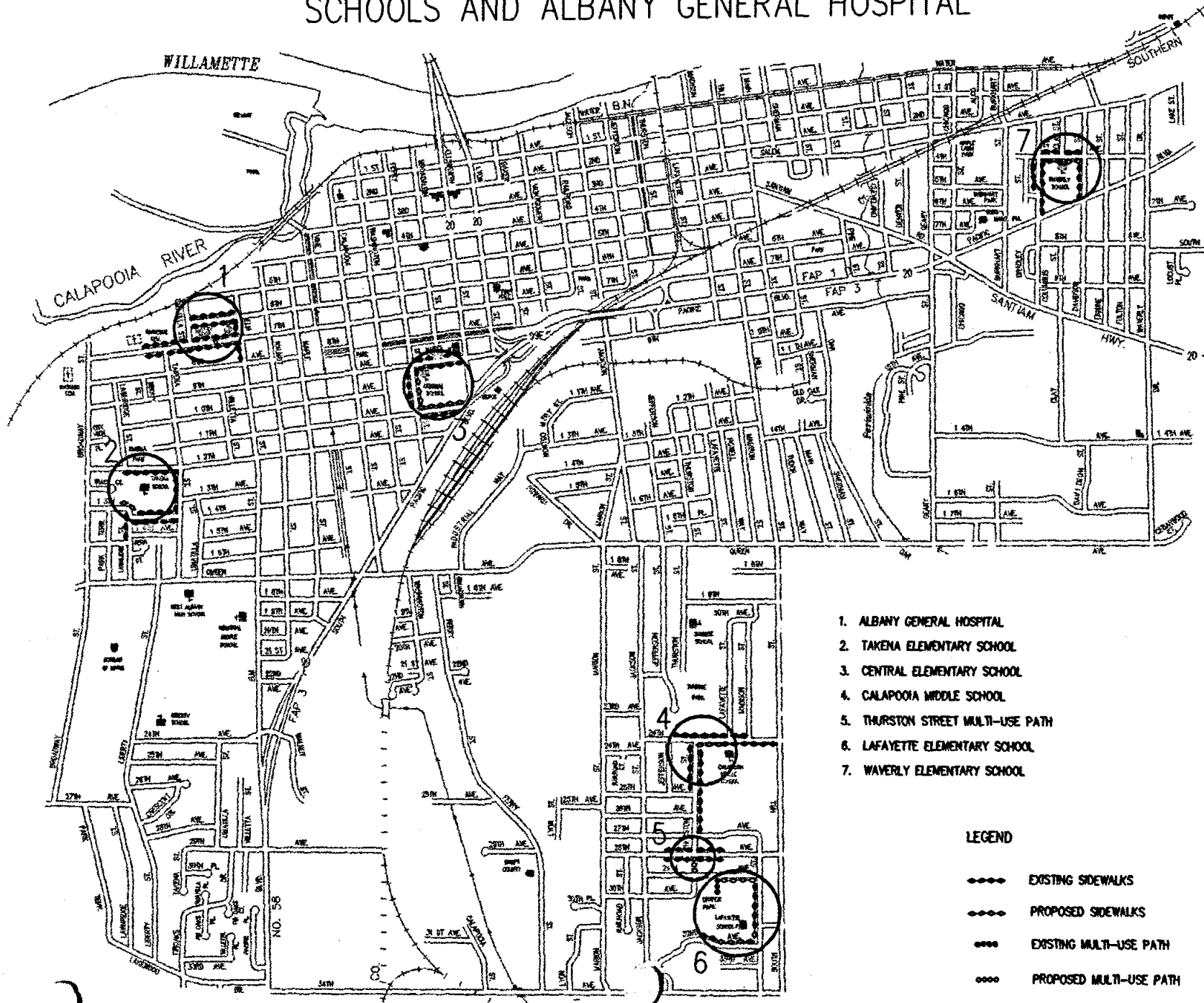
