

RESOLUTION NO. 4095

**A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON THE PURCHASE OF A SKID STEER LOADER WITH IMPLEMENT PACKAGE.**

WHEREAS, Albany Municipal Code exempts contracts from competitive bids when there is only one seller or price of a product of the quality required is available within a reasonable purchase area; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Revised Statutes waive competitive bidding on finding that:


1. It is unlikely that such exemption will encourage favoritism in the awarding of public contracts or substantially diminish competition for public contracts; and
2. The awarding of public contracts pursuant to the exemption will result in substantial cost savings to the public contracting agency; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department desires to purchase a skid steer loader with implement package to meet the Department's requirements and to avoid substantial rental fees for this equipment to complete the scheduled projects; and

WHEREAS, Fisher Implement is the sole source provider for this equipment in the immediate purchase area; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council adopts the findings and waives the requirement for competitive bidding in this instance for the purchase of the skid steer loader with implement package.
