

RESOLUTION NO. 4249

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE ALBANY PARATRANSIT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Transportation Network, via the Oregon Department of Transportation, has offered the City of Albany (Paratransit/Call-A-Ride) a grant in the amount of \$20,000 for replacement of a Call-A-Ride sedan; and

WHEREAS, the City has grant funds available through the Linn County Special Transportation Funds Grant (STF) (Resolution No. 4216) to provide \$4,000 of matching funds for replacement of the Call-A-Ride sedan; and


WHEREAS, the replacement of the Call-A-Ride sedan will improve the quality of transportation and continue to allow the Call-A-Ride program to provide reliable and safe transportation to all elderly and American Disability Act-eligible citizens of Albany; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this Community Transportation Grant in the amount of \$20,000 for replacement of a sedan used by the Call-A-Ride program.
