

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF BALLOT MEASURE 84

WHEREAS Ballot Measure 84 Amends the State Constitution whereby the State Must Continue Paying Local Government for State-Mandated Programs, and

WHEREAS Ballot Measure 84 retains Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution requiring the State Legislature to pay local governments for the costs of new state-mandated programs or increased level of services for state-mandated programs, and


WHEREAS the "no unfunded mandates" provision of the State Constitution was originally approved in 1996, and included a provision that it would be repealed if it were not reaffirmed in November 2000, and

WHEREAS the fiscal impact statement for all legislation and proposals for the Governor's budget considered the possible impact on local governments, and

WHEREAS the city's finances may be adversely impacted should Ballot Measure not be passed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council does hereby go on record as supporting Ballot Measure 84, and encourages others to support the Ballot Measure also.
