

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF ALBANY MISSION STATEMENT AND REVISED VISION STATEMENT

WHEREAS, in the early 1990s, the Albany City Council adopted statements reflecting its assessment of the community, the mission of City government and a vision for its future; and

WHEREAS, in the intervening years, the City and the community have experienced significant economic and demographic changes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to help direct future change by bringing balance to the community through more opportunities for living-wage jobs, quality neighborhood shopping areas, a strong urban core, and a variety of well-designed housing types that meet the needs of all who want to live here; and

WHEREAS, members of the Council on January 26, 2001, engaged in an earnest evaluation of those statements, found the vision statement lacking, and came to a strong consensus on new wording.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany mission statement will continue to read:

"Providing quality public services for a better Albany."

And the revised vision statement will read:

"A vital and diversified community that promotes a high quality of life, great neighborhoods, balanced economic growth, and quality public services."
