A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT FROM THE STATE OF OREGON TO COMPLETE THE BALANCED DEVELOPMENT PATTERNS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany submitted a work program for Periodic Review that included a task to examine urban development patterns, and the Department of Land Conservation and Development approved the work program on September 30, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the state of Oregon awarded the City of Albany a Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) Grant during the 1999-2001 biennium for the Balanced Development Patterns project to prepare a conceptual plan for future development patterns and a refinement plan for one of three subareas; and

WHEREAS, to complete the Balanced Development Patterns project, work is needed to apply the preferred development pattern to two remaining subareas and to complete the amendments to the Comprehensive Plan and Development Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council supports an application for a TGM Grant to prepare refinement plans in the North Albany and Oak Creek subareas and to prepare Comprehensive Plan and Development implementing measures to complete the Balanced Development Patterns project.
