A RESOLUTION URGING BOTH PARTIES IN THE CURRENT TELEDYNE WAH CHANG LABOR DISPUTE TO REACH A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the current work stoppage at Wah Chang has caused tremendous economic hardship to families, individuals, and businesses in the Albany community, and

WHEREAS, the further continuation of the contract dispute will cause long term damage to the Albany economy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council urges both management and union representatives to aggressively seek the needed compromises, do whatever is necessary to reach agreement, and return all Wah Chang employees to work.
