

RESOLUTION NO. 4823

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE GOVERNOR'S INDUSTRIAL LANDS' TASK FORCE PLACE A PRIORITY ON THE STATE'S PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE SO THAT CITIES CAN PROVIDE 'PROJECT READY' INDUSTRIAL SITES.

WHEREAS, Governor Kulongoski has issued an Executive Order creating an Industrial Lands' Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the charge of this task force is to assist the Governor in identifying what works and doesn't work in providing an adequate land supply in Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the task force is seeking feedback from cities and others interested in the industrial lands issue; and

WHEREAS, the task force is exploring a program whereby certain select sites would be certified as "project ready"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany believes that lack of funding for public infrastructure is the biggest problem the City faces in providing "project ready" industrial land.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany recommends to the Governor's Industrial Lands' Task Force that the State place its priority on providing grant and loan assistance for public infrastructure so that cities can provide "project ready" industrial sites to attract industries paying family wage jobs.
