

RESOLUTION NO. 5387

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BUILDING SAFER COMMUNITIES MINI-GRANT FROM THE ALLIANCE FOR COMMUNITY TRAFFIC SAFETY (ACTS) OREGON.

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting on October 25, 2006, the Albany City Council approved the submittal of a grant application to the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety (ACTS) Oregon in the amount of \$5,000 for the purchase of an enclosed trailer; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to coordinate with the Bicycle Transportation Alliance to purchase a trailer to more efficiently store and transport a fleet of 35 bicycles and related equipment used in the Bike Education Program; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission, the Greater Albany School District and the Bicycle Transportation Alliance collaborate to provide the Bike Education Program to local 5th grade students; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this Building Safer Communities Mini-Grant in the amount of \$5,000 for the purpose of purchasing an enclosed trailer for the storage and transportation of bicycles and equipment used in the Bike Education Program.
