

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACCEPTANCE OF THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SPEED MEASUREMENT EQUIPMENT GRANT TO RECEIVE TWO (2) MPH PYTHON RADARS.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation makes grants available through their Law Enforcement for Traffic Safety Committee to provide speed measurement equipment to law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Police Department has been invited and approved to receive two (2) MPH Python Radars; and

WHEREAS, grant acceptance will add new speed measurement equipment not budgeted for; and

WHEREAS, grant acceptance will require local match by reporting the hours of use and number of citations issued per year for three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council does hereby state that monitoring and enforcing speed limits is a priority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the Albany Police Department to accept these MPH Python Radars valued at \$2,884.
