A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LICENSE TO OCCUPY THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY TO SAMARITAN ALBANY GENERAL HOSPITAL.

WHEREAS, Chapter 14.04 of the Albany Municipal Code sets forth the authority of the City Council to issue licenses to occupy public property, including rights-of-way, as long as certain conditions are met, subject to the restrictions in the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Samaritan Albany General Hospital has requested a license to occupy the public right-ofway on Elm Street for the placement and maintenance of a fiber-optic cable in a conduit, as described and defined in encroachment permit # E-0056-12; and

WHEREAS, Samaritan Albany General Hospital's request meets the conditions identified in Chapter 14.014 of the Albany Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Encroachment permit # E-0056-12 identifies conditions of the license and indemnifies and holds harmless the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, Samaritan Albany General Hospital has agreed to participate as an Operator in the Oregon Utility Notification Center's system for locating underground facilities if approved for this license.



LICENSE TO OCCUPY PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

ENCROACHMENT PERMIT # E-0056-12



The City of Albany ("Licensor") hereby authorizes Samaritan Albany General Hospital, an Oregon nonprofit corporation ("Licensee") to encroach upon the Licensor's public right-of-way under the terms and specifications set forth herein.

1. Location and Nature of Encroachment: This License shall apply to Licensee and shall allow all reasonable and necessary access for the installation and subsequent alteration, modification, repair and maintenance of a private utility fiber optic cable, and all related accessory and component parts and equipment thereof, as shown on Exhibit "A," and "B" attached hereto, under the Licensor's public right-of-way between two parcels of real property, and the buildings and other improvements located thereon, at 832 Elm Street SW and 1020 11th Avenue SW in Albany, Linn County, Oregon. A more particular description of the area within the Licensor's public right-of-way that this License encompasses is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and "B".

2. Conditions of License:

- a. The Licensee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Licensor, and other franchise utilities located in the public right-of-way closely enough to be affected by this encroachment, their agents, officers, and employees from all damages, claims, or liability arising from its use of the public right-of-way pursuant to the terms of this License. Licensee's indemnity shall cover the acts of any agents, contractors, subcontractors, representatives, or employees of Licensee for any negligence or intentional acts or omissions with regard to the installation and subsequent alteration, modification, repair and maintenance of the fiber optic cable, and all related accessory and component parts and equipment thereof, and any work or other activities within the public right-of-way that may give rise to liability arising out of the use of this License by Licensee. Licensee shall promptly repair any damage it may cause to the area affected by this License caused by the installation, and subsequent alteration, modification, repair and maintenance of the fiber optic cable, and all related accessory and component parts and equipment thereof, so that the area is restored to its original pre- existing condition prior to the work. All work done pursuant to this permit shall be performed in accordance with City standards including engineering and construction specifications.
- b. The Licensee agrees to repair and maintain all of Licensee's private improvements within the public right-of-way.
- c. This License shall be subject to revocation without cause after 90 days written notice by the Licensor as provided by AMC 14.04.010. C'
- d. This License may be revoked, at any time, for failure of the Licensee to comply with the terms of this License after 10 days' notice of revocation.
- e. If, during the course of maintaining or installing private infrastructure, the Licensee encounters or disturbs any of Licensor's public improvements within the right-of-way or those of any franchise utility, it shall be the Licensee's responsibility to remove and/or repair said improvements at the Licensee's expense. The Licensee shall also be responsible for any damages or delays that result from said improvements. However, if the disturbance is caused through the Licensor's gross negligence or intentional acts or omissions, the Licensor shall be responsible for any required repairs.

- 3. Notices. Notices shall be given as provided in AMC 14.04.030.
- 4. Liens. Licensor shall have the authority to impose a lien upon the property as provided for in AMC 14.04.040.
- 5. Binding Upon Heirs and Assigns. Unless earlier terminated by either party, the terms of this License shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon, the parties, their heirs, devisees, successors, and assigns. The terms of an encroaching structure pursuant the terms of AMC 14.04.040 and of this License shall constitute a covenant running with all of the land described in Exhibit "A" and "B" attached hereto.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION for PRIVATE UTILITY LICENSE AGREEMENT
