

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY TO SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2015-18 STIP ENHANCE, 2012 TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT, AND THE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT DISCRETIONARY GRANT FUNDS TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ALBANY STATION PATHWAY, AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has three grant programs for which this project could qualify; and

WHEREAS, the City submitted a Notice of Intent to apply for the 2012 Transportation Enhancement program and ODOT has invited and encouraged the City to submit grant applications for each grant program; and

WHEREAS, a minimum local match of 10.27 percent is required for the grant programs; and

WHEREAS, a receipt of these funds will allow the City to complete the multiuse pathway that will connect the pathway currently ending at the parking lot for Cool Pool at Swanson Park to the pathway currently ending at the Albany Transit Center parking lot; and

WHEREAS, completion of this pathway is the final phase of the overall renovation and improvement of the Albany Multimodal Transit Station (AMTS), REA Building, parking lots and associated pathways; and



WHEREAS, these grant program applications will request \$410,000 for completion of the Albany Station Pathway and the City of Albany's local match will be approximately \$47,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of grant applications to ODOT for the 2015-18 STIP Enhance, 2012 Transportation Enhancement, and the Transportation Enhancement Discretionary programs for the purpose of completing the Albany Station Pathway.
