

RESOLUTION NO. 6368

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A COOPERATIVE IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PEDESTRIAN-ACTIVATED WARNING LIGHTS ON SANTIAM HIGHWAY NEAR BAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, the adopted 2014-2015 budget for the City of Albany provides for pedestrian crossing improvements at several existing mid-block pedestrian crossings shown on the attached vicinity map (Attachment A); and

WHEREAS, one of the project locations is on Santiam Highway west of Bain Street; and

WHEREAS, Santiam Highway is under the jurisdiction of the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT); and

WHEREAS, pending execution of a Cooperative Improvement Agreement, ODOT has approved the installation of pedestrian-activated warning lights at this crossing location in order to improve the safety of pedestrians and motorists; and

WHEREAS, the crossing improvements will be paid for and maintained by the City of Albany.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts the attached Cooperative Improvement Agreement (Attachment B); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the attached Cooperative Improvement Agreement.
