

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL TRANSFER AGREEMENT WITH THE OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF AMBULANCE TRANSPORT COSTS

WHEREAS, the Ground Emergency Medical Transportation (GEMT) program provides expense reimbursement costs to publicly owned or operated qualified providers; and

WHEREAS, Albany Fire Department is a qualified provider of ground emergency medical transport services; and

WHEREAS, beginning with FY 2017-2018, the fire department may seek annual reimbursement for the difference between the cost of providing ambulance transport service and what is actually paid by Medicaid; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Health Authority is tasked with implementing the program and the fire department must enter into an agreement with the state of Oregon to receive funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the fire chief execute an intergovernmental transfer agreement with the state of Oregon through the Oregon Health Authority.
