



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration has announced the availability of grant funds for public transit facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation has worked cooperatively with Albany staff to develop a grant proposal for new public restrooms at the Albany Multimodal Station; and

WHEREAS, there are not currently restrooms available to the general public at the Station; and

WHEREAS, providing public restrooms generally available to those traveling to and through Albany promotes good health and hygiene; and

WHEREAS, a local match of a maximum of 20 percent is required; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow for the design, construction, and initial maintenance of a new restroom at the Station; and



WHEREAS, this grant application will request \$164,800 in grant funds for costs associated with design, construction, and initial maintenance of the new facility, and the City of Albany's local match will be a maximum of \$41,200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to the Federal Transit Administration for the purpose of design, construction, and initial maintenance of a new public restroom facility.
