



RESOLUTION NO. 6943

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ADDITIONS TO THE APPROVED RATE SCHEDULE FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY ALBANY-LEBANON SANITATION, D/B/A REPUBLIC SERVICES

WHEREAS, Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, d/b/a Republic Services, has an exclusive franchise agreement with the City of Albany whereby Republic Services is permitted to collect, transport, and convey solid waste and recyclable materials within the city and to reuse, recycle, or otherwise recover materials or energy from such solid waste and dispose of the remainder; and

WHEREAS, the methodology for annual rate adjustments for those services provided by Republic Services is outlined in Resolution No. 6019; and

WHEREAS, Republic Services presented proposed additions to the approved rate schedule for collection and disposal services at the October 14, 2020, City Council Meeting, which included the addition of a third cart size for residential trash as well as the addition of a contamination fee for recycling or yard debris carts that are contaminated with non-recyclable materials; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council agreed that the approved rate schedule should be amended to reflect those additions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the approved rate schedule for collection and disposal services provided by Republic Services as part of their exclusive franchise agreement with the City of Albany shall be amended to include the items marked as proposed in the attached Exhibit A.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that future rate adjustments shall continue to be evaluated using the methodology and process provided for in Resolution No. 6019.

Exhibit A

Proposed Additions to the Approved Rate Sheet

65-yard Cart Service

We currently offer 32 and 90-gallon carts for residential trash. The 65-gallon cart provides another option for Albany customers who may need either a smaller cart or a larger cart. The rates for the 32 and 90-gallon carts are below with a proposed rate for the 65-gallon cart.

32-gallon cart:	\$20.56 per month
90-gallon cart:	\$32.37 per month
65-gallon cart:	\$27.30 per month (Proposed)

Recycling/Yard Debris Contamination Fee

This fee would be charged when the driver sees plastic bags in either recycling or yard debris carts on the hopper camera inside the truck. Customer account would be noted, with a warning letter sent on the first offense. The fee would be assessed only if contamination occurs again.
