A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation has offered Albany a Safe Routes to School Grant in the amount of \$239,300 to fund the construction of a multi-use path and crossing improvements on Queen Avenue in the vicinity of Sunrise Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany supports the creation of a safe and efficient pedestrian system for students and residents alike; and


WHEREAS, construction of pedestrian improvements in the vicinity of Sunrise Elementary School would benefit both students and residents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Transportation System Development Charge funds are hereby appropriated as follows:


