A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL, ACTING AS THE LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH XIOLOGIX TO PURCHASE COMPUTER HARDWARE

WHEREAS, the components of the existing Hyper-V infrastructure for the City's Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) equipment are nearing the end of their useful life; and

WHEREAS, the purchase includes computer hardware upgrades and additional digital storage space with components to support future technology and replacement of the current system; and

WHEREAS, the equipment supports historical logging, network security software, and closed-circuit television (CCTV) functions in the SCADA infrastructure for treatment facilities and distribution and collection systems; and

WHEREAS, City staff conducted market research and found that a competitive request for proposals was conducted by lead agency Region 14 Education Service Center on behalf of National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance (NCPA); and

WHEREAS, Contract 01-82 was awarded to Dell EMC, and Xiologix is an approved reseller; and

WHEREAS, the contract was established by a competitive request for proposal process substantially equivalent to those specified in ORS 279B.055 and 279B.060; however, the solicitation was not advertised in Oregon; and

WHEREAS, contingent upon City Council approval, a notice of intent to award a contract will be advertised on April 19, 2021, with a seven-day protest period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council, acting as the local contract review board, authorizes an exemption from the competitive bidding process to use an interstate cooperative agreement provided by NCPA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the public works director to enter into a contract with Xiologix to purchase computer hardware for \$115,159.76.
