A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) AND OREGON BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT (OBDD) TO PARTNER IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE UNIFIED CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program requirements in Title 49 CFR Part 26, Section 81 require that state recipients of federal transportation funds establish a single process to certify businesses owned by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals to administer the DBE Unified Certification Function; and

WHEREAS, ODOT is responsible for ensuring compliance with the federal regulations in the determination of a DBE certification; and

WHEREAS, OBDD is the sole agency authorized to certify enterprises as DBEs eligible to perform on public contracts in the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the City receives funding for federal transportation functions and activities and is required to comply with 49 CFR §26.81, Requirements for a Unified Certification Program; and

WHEREAS, the IGA defines the roles and responsibilities of ODOT, OBDD, and other state federal-fund recipients, including the City of Albany, that guide the partnership for the Unified Certification Program (UCP); and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Agreement state the parties will cooperate and coordinate the administration of the DBE certification function for a period of five years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the Public Works Director is authorized to execute an IGA with ODOT and OBDD for five years to assist with the administration of the DBE Unified Certification Program, as provided in the IGA, Attachment A.
