



RESOLUTION NO. 7233

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY SERVICE FEES, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 6903

WHEREAS, the city council reviews and authorizes service fees; and

WHEREAS, the city council established and maintains a fee schedule for various fire department permits (Resolution No. 6903); and

WHEREAS, the fire department has identified the need to adjust the fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the fire plans review fee was that it be applied to all commercial plan reviews charged by the community development building division for all projects regulated under the Oregon Structural Specialty Code (OSSC); and


WHEREAS, the fire department participates in approval and inspection of fire-related systems permits such as commercial fire alarm, fire sprinkler, fire hydrant, fire line, and hood suppression permits without recovery for staff time; and

WHEREAS, the fire department participates in land use action application review, site research, correspondence with design professionals and staff without recovery for staff time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the fees described in Exhibit A to be established effective July 1, 2023, for services provided by the fire department; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 6903 is hereby repealed.

Inside City Limits - applicable to standpipes, connections for automatic sprinkler systems, and fire hydrant service for private fire protection located within city limits.

Monthly rates as listed for Inside City Limits with a 10 percent surcharge on said rates for service outside the city limits.

Special Conditions for all Fire Protection Services - water taken under this classification is to be used only to extinguish fires and for flushing necessary to maintain fire protection equipment. In case of surreptitious or improper use of water, the consumption may be estimated, and the water used shall be billed at regular meter rates.
